









HOW TO BUILD A SNOWMAN BOOK




1 Print this template first.




3 Fold the paper in half horizontally.



Open the paper back up.
Then fold it in half
vertically.



2 Print this template on the BACK of the first template. The text should be on the left side of the paper as shown in the picture.



Unfold the paper again. Cut along the creased horizontal line on the right-hand side above the snowman's eyes. STOP CUTTING AT THE CENTER OF THE PAPER.

HOW TO BUILD A SNOWMAN BOOK



6 Fold the paper in half horizontally one last time.



The page order of the book when completely assembled:

- I. Snowman cover
- 4. Then
- 2. First
- 5. After that
- 3. Next
- 6. Last



- 7 Fold this half sheet of paper in half vertically so that the snowman is on the front. The finished booklet size is ¼ of a piece of printer paper.
- 8 Print the hat template on black paper and cut out. Glue it to the top of the snowman.

Cut a small triangle from orange paper and glue it under the eyes.

Print the scarf template on colored paper and cut out. Cut fringe at the end of the smaller scarf piece. Glue the longer scarf piece across the front between the nose and buttons, gluing the smaller scarf piece vertically beneath it.






